The event ended with an inspiring speech by the judges who appreciated and applauded the performances of the participants and also encouraged them for their future endeavours.

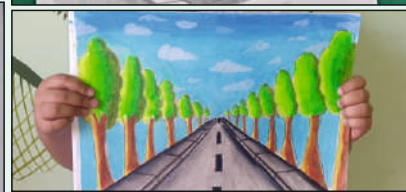
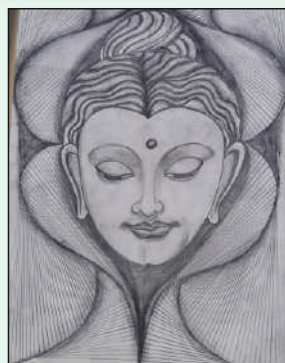
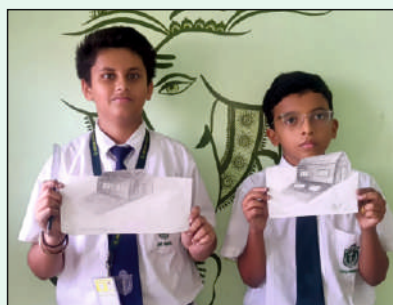
ART AND CRAFT
