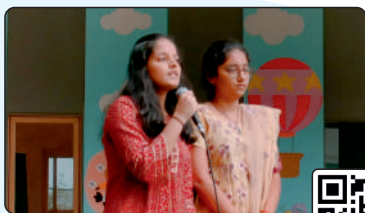

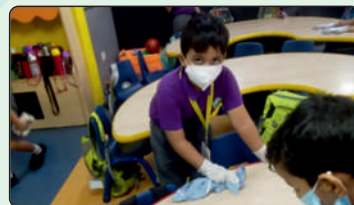

The team proposed an enliven session for students of all Xth graders and acquainted them with the career development options available in the competitive world today.

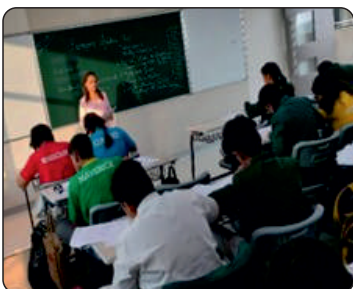
The stream in-charges got down to the nitty gritty of finding an apt subject combination after

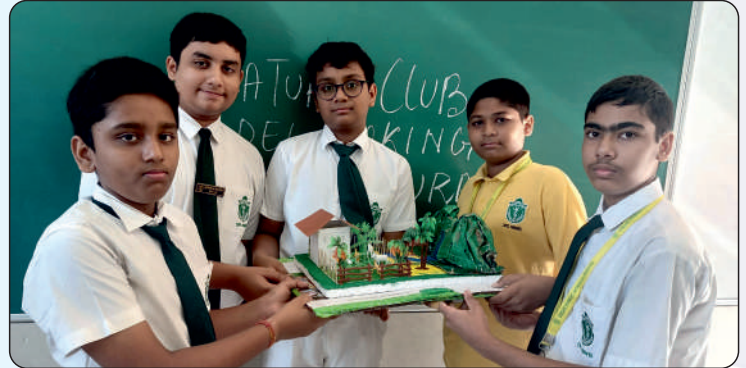
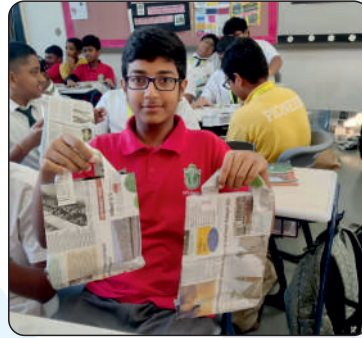
### FRAGRANT SPRING
